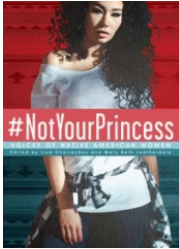

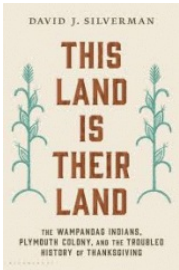

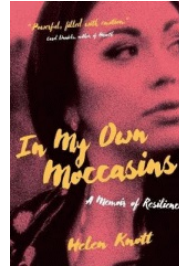
#NotYourPrincess : voices of Native American women

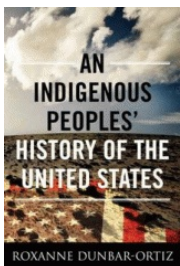
