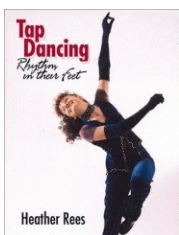


Dance Books: Tap and Jazz

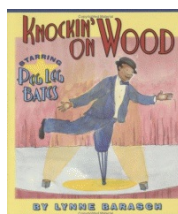

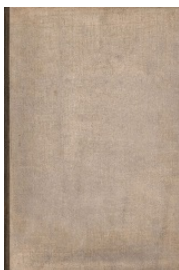
